- ✦ *To receive the wine, hold the bottom of the cup and guide it to your mouth.*
- ✦ *If you prefer to receive a blessing, indicate this by crossing your arms over your chest.*
- ✦ *For health reasons, dipping the bread in the wine is not permitted.*
- ✦ *If you require gluten-free wafers, please indicate at the time of receiving.*

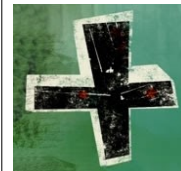
