- ♦ To receive the wine, hold the bottom of the cup and guide it to your mouth.
- † If you prefer to receive a blessing, indicate this by crossing your arms over your chest.
- † For health reasons, dipping the bread in the wine is not permitted.
- † If you require gluten-free wafers, please indicate at the time of receiving.
